

Jamie Reed – MP for Copeland



Jamie Reed has been the Member of UK Parliament for Copeland (which includes the Sellafield site) since the 2005 general election.

Recent roles have included, Shadow Minister for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (2010-11), before becoming a Shadow Health Minister (2011-15).

Jamie is now a member of the Energy and Climate Change Committee. He also Vice-Chairs the Nuclear Energy All Party Parliamentary Group with neighbouring Workington MP, Sue Hayman.

As a former Press Officer for British Nuclear Fuels Ltd (2001-05), he is supportive of Sellafield Ltd and the company's wider social programmes.

Locally Jamie had been active in securing a new hospital in Whitehaven, his home town. He continues to support delivery of new nuclear in West Cumbria and for the local area to be seen as the UK centre of nuclear excellence.
