Now he works in the Nuclear Safety Institute of Russian Academy of Sciences as Deputy director on development of computer codes for nuclear safety.

His professional interests are concentrated on the NPP safety including severe accidents. He participated in several projects on corium behavior and code developments for nuclear safety: OECD RASPLAV MASCA dealing with the behavior of molten prototypic core materials in the lower head.
