F1 Decommissioning takes time and hard work

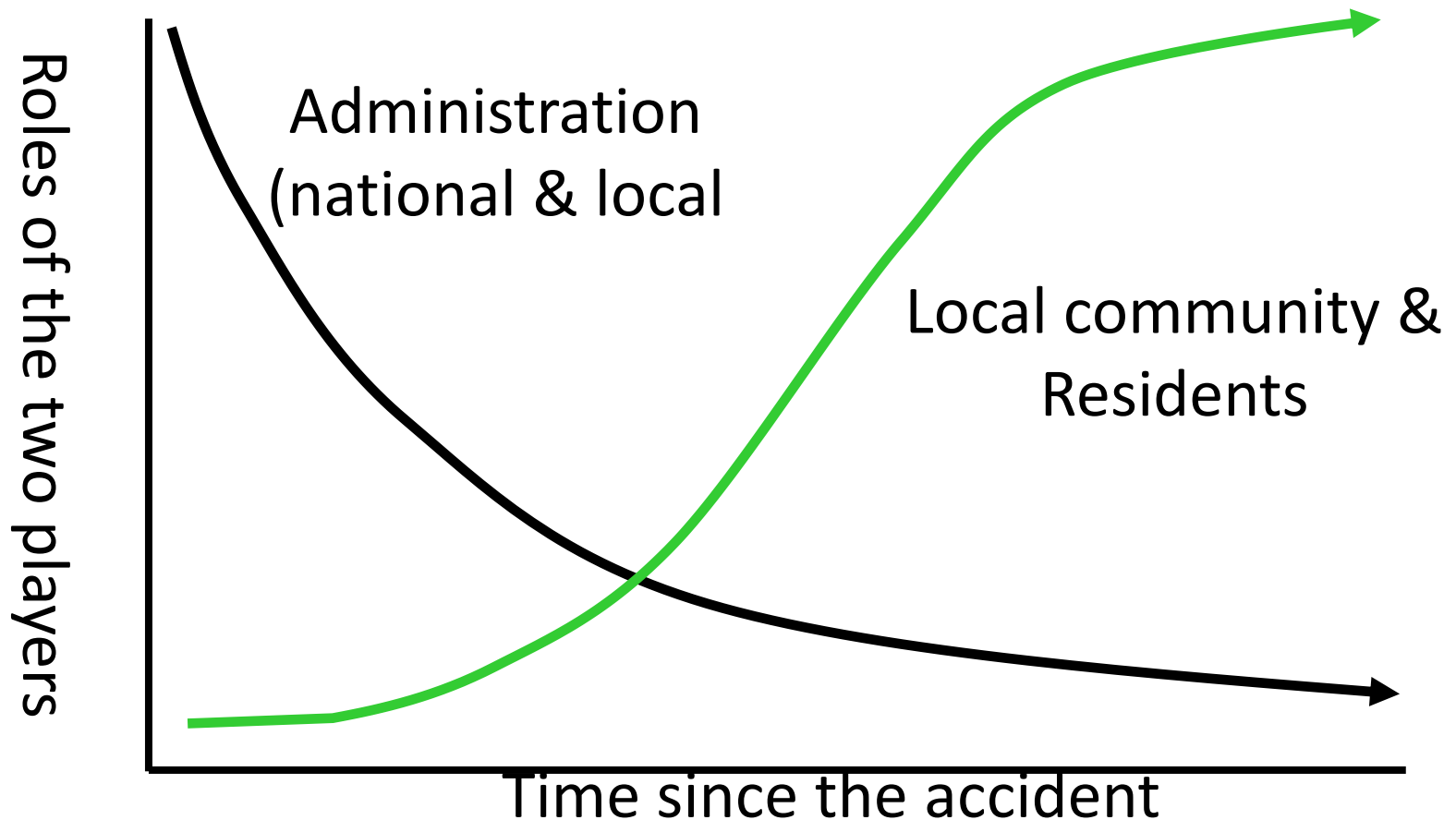
It is the duty to the authority, and its failure leads to the loss of credence

District unit: shares  
culture and daily  
activity

Individual unit:

Municipality unit is biased toward unidirectionality and sharing with residents is ineffective, while sharing directly with individual is unstable. Sharing and consensus building at the district unit could be the key
