M. Kraus joined the CEA in 1989, as a R&D engineer in materials design and development. In the following years, he occupied different post of responsibilities, including head of section for design and synthesis of organic materials and head of laboratory for design and realization of complex sub-assemblies. In 2004 he was appointed as head of service in charge of plutonium management and recycling. He then moved on to be the head of the CEA Moronvilliers R&D center until 2009. He was then appointed to be head of the nuclear technology department, in charge of more than 200 people, overseeing the development of new technologies for Gen II and Gen III reactors, but also for the next generation of reactors. Since 2015 he is the deputy director of the Dismantling and Decommissioning Nuclear direction, inside the nuclear energy division. This branch of the nuclear energy division oversees and manages all the activities of CEA concerning D&D, on all its components : R&D, project management, budget management, etc...
