Born in 1971 in Toyota City, Aichi Prefecture. Member of a volunteer group engaged in revitalization of the Naraha Town community. Coming to Fukushima for the first time as a worker to decommission the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station, he was captivated by the attractiveness of Fukushima, alien to him up to that time, and moved in there. Hoping to revitalize the lands that left a desolate impression on him when working at the power station, and to create attractive conditions for people visiting from outside, he began producing tanbo (rice field) art. This year, he is growing rice in Naraha Town with local high school students. While living in Yotsukura, Iwaki City, and Naraha Town, where he maintains his rice fields, he works at “Yui-no Hajimari”, a small restaurant in Kido.
